A quorum being present, the Police Jury of Catahoula Parish, State of Louisiana, was duly convened as governing body of said parish by President Harold Sones who called upon Rodney Sones for prayer and requested that the Jurors and public remain standing for the Pledge of Allegiance after which the following business was transacted.

On a motion by Rodney Sones, seconded by Jeffery Estes and unanimously passed, the Jury voted to approve the agenda.

President Sones opened the floor for public comments on agenda items. There were no public comments.
