The Police Jury of the Parish of Catahoula, State of Louisiana, met in Regular Session at its regular meeting place, the Police Jury Meeting Room at the Courthouse, on Monday, May 10, 2021 at 6:00 P.M.

Present: President Harold Sones, Vice President Jerel Evans and Jurors Brady Nelson, Deborah McCormack, Jeffery Estes, Johnnie Adams; Secretary-Treasurer Patti C. Mizell, Assistant Secretary Frankie Tolar, Road Supervisor Charles Atkins and Attorney Karla McHand.

Absent: Jurors: Rodney Sones, Rickie Crumpton and Debra Hawkins

A quorum being present, the Police Jury of the Parish of Catahoula, State of Louisiana, was duly convened as the governing authority of said parish by President Harold Sones, who called upon Hiram Evans for Prayer and requested that the Jurors and the public remain standing for the Pledge of Allegiance after which the following business was transacted.

On motion by Jerel Evans, seconded by Jeffery Estes and unanimously passed, the Jury voted to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the last meeting and adopt same as published in the Official Journal.

On motion by Jeffery Estes, seconded by Johnnie Adams and unanimously passed, the Jury voted to add the following item to the agenda:

Approve the purchase and installation of a 24x26 culvert for Earl Road.

On motion by Deborah McCormack, seconded by Jerel Evans and unanimously passed, the Jury voted to approve the Agenda.

President Sones opened the comment period for agenda items. There were no comments from the public on agenda items.

On a motion by Jerel Evans seconded by Johnnie Adams and unanimously passed, the Jury voted to authorize payment of current invoices approved by the Finance Committee.

On a motion by Jeffery Estes, seconded by Jerel Evans and unanimously passed, the Jury voted to authorize the following additions to the Selective Maintenance List:

President Sones stated that Kay King has resigned her

appointment as Ward 3 Constable. The Secretary of State has given until May 17th for the Jury to make another appointment until the Special Election can be held. Discussion was held, but no action was taken.

On motion by Brady Nelson, seconded by Jeffery Estes and unanimously passed, the Jury approved 100 yards of pit run for Doty Road.

On motion by Brady Nelson, seconded by Deborah McCormack and unanimously passed, the Jury approved 70 yards of pit run for Means Lake Road (emergency).

On motion by Jerel Evans, seconded by Jeffery Estes and unanimously passed, the Jury approved 50 yards of pit run for the end of Coon Road.

On motion by Johnnie Adams, seconded by Jerel Evans and unanimously passed, the Jury approved the purchase and installation of a 15x24 culvert and a 15x30 culvert for Willow Lake Road.

On motion by Brady Nelson, seconded by Jerel Evans and unanimously passed, the Jury approved an amendment to the E911 Policy Manual concerning mileage and overtime reimbursement for after-hours work for E911.

On motion by Johnnie Adams, seconded by Jerel Evans and unanimously passed, the Jury approved the purchase and installation of a 36x30 culvert for Willow Lake Road.

Aon motion by Deborah McCormack, seconded by Jeffery Estes and unanimously passed, the Jury approve the employment of Robert Calhoun in the Hardsurface Department at \$11.00 per hour for a four-month probation period, pending physical and drug screen.

President Sones stated that Ellis Boothe has resigned as the Jury's representative on the Kisatchie-Delta Board and the Jury would have to make another appointment. Discussion was held, but no action was taken.

On motion by Deborah McCormack, seconded by Brady Nelson and unanimously passed, the Jury approved the appointment of the following to the Catahoula Parish Fire District #5 Board: Red Renfrow, Richard Williamson, Benny Jones, Gerald Hughes and David Breithaupt

On motion by Jeffery Estes, seconded by Johnnie Adams and unanimously passed, the Jury approved the purchase and installation of a 24x26 culvert for Earl Road.

President Sones that the Police Jury Office and the Maintenance barn will be closed Monday, May 31, 2021 in observance of Memorial Day.

President Sones stated that the Jurors had the Financial reports for April 2021 (which included budget to actual figures) at their seats. He encouraged the review and comparison of these reports.

On a motion by Jerel Evans, seconded by Johnnie Adams and unanimously passed, the Jury voted there being no further business to adjourn.
