infusions. There will be a dedicated entrance near the west side of the building next to Los Cabos. Each room contains a medical

grade HEPA filter, capable of removing even the smallest of particles (0.1 microns) and each room is thoroughly disinfected between patients. Rooms have comfortable seating with reclining chairs and Wi-fi access for patients testing positive for COVID. King adds, "We have 6 treatment rooms, which will allow us to treat around 30 patients per day. That's 30 patients who may not have to be hospitalized or—God-forbid—

placed on a vent, but instead can recover at home with conservative treatment." Treatments are FREE for most patients, even many uninsured. The cash price for an infusion is \$175. Many uninsured patients will not likely require payment depending on the availability of COVID-relief government funding through HRSA.

Patients with COVID symptoms who haven't seen a provider, may receive rapid COVID testing at the clinic during design-

nated time periods (Mon-Thurs 10am-11:30am and Fridays from 10am-11:30am). Delta Med will accept referrals from other providers and will require the following information in order for the patient to be scheduled:

1) positive test result, 2)an order for REGEN-COV, 3)patient demographic sheet with TWO contact numbers for the patient. Providers may fax OR email the patient's contact information in order to request an appointment.
