The Catahoula Parish School Board, State of Louisiana, met at the Catahoula Parish School Board Meeting Room, Harrisonburg, Louisiana on October 5, 2021 at 6:00 P.M.

There were present: Board President - Dewey Stockman, Katie Adams, John Allbritton, Cynthia Brown, Toshiro Fisher, Tillman Jolly, Jane Martin, Sharon Fisher- Stevenson and Dorothy Watson.

There was absent: None

The meeting was opened with prayer by John Allbritton, and Toshiro Fisher led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

On a motion by Cynthia Brown, seconded by Katie Adams, and passed unanimously, the Board approved the minutes from the September 7, 2021 regular meeting.

On a motion by Dorothy Watson, seconded by Toshiro Fisher and passed unanimously, the Board approved providing employees with 10 days of paid COVID leave in addition to employees' normal sick leave for the 2021-2022 school year, retroactive to August 3, 2021.

On a motion by Dorothy Watson, seconded by Cynthia Brown, and unanimously passed, the Board approved a contract with ABA School Consultants, LLC to provide instructional and behavioral consultations services through the 2021-2022 school year to be paid with IDEA Funds Part B and IDEA Preschool.

On a motion Cynthia Brown, seconded by Katie Adams, and unanimously passed, the Board approved an inter-agency agreement between the Catahoula Parish School Board and the Catahoula Parish Head Start to provide for a collaborative and cooperative arrangement between Head Start and School Board.

On a motion by Dorothy Watson, seconded by Jane Martin, and unanimously passed, the Board approved a contract with PC Brocato, LLC, providing professional development to be paid with IDEA Part B and IDEA Preschool Funds.

On a motion by Sharon Fisher-Stevenson, seconded by Jane Martin, and unanimously passed, the Board authorized the Superintendent to sign the appropriate forms rejecting Uninsured/Underinsured Motorist Coverage.
