

# CATAHOULA LEGALS

## NOTICE

Notice is hereby given out of an abundance of caution, pursuant to Article IV, Section 21(D)(1) of the Louisiana Constitution, that on November 30, 2020 Entergy Louisiana, LLC ("ELL"), an electric public utility providing retail electric service to customers in fifty-eight (58) parishes of the State of Louisiana, filed with the Louisiana Public Service Commission ("LPSC"), its Formula Rate Plan Rider Schedule FRP Interim Update and workpapers. The filing reflects the interim Formula Rate Plan ("FRP") factors resulting from a reduction in Guaranteed Customer Credits pursuant to LPSC Order No. U-33244-A and the placement in service of Washington Parish Energy Center, approved by LPSC Order No. U-34472. The net increase in FRP rates will be \$39.654 million. Except for those rate schedules excluded under ELL Rider Schedule FRP-1, the required interim FRP factor of 57.3211% is to be applied to each of Legacy ELL's rate classes and the required interim FRP factor of 55.8383% is to be applied to each of Legacy EGSL's rate classes, both effective for monthly customer bills rendered on and after the first billing cycle of December 2020.

It is estimated that the adjustment in rates will have the following effects upon applicable Legacy ELL customers' typical monthly bills (based on the Fuel Adjustment Clause and other riders for the month of November 2020): a typical monthly bill for a Residential customer using 1,000 kWh would increase approximately \$1.15, from \$101.79 to \$102.94; a typical monthly bill for a Small General Service customer using 50 kW and 12,500 kWh would increase approximately \$16.29, from \$1,404.36 to \$1,420.65; a typical monthly bill for a Large General Service customer using 1,000 kW and 500,000 kWh would increase approximately \$368.72, from \$36,565.18 to \$36,933.90.

It is estimated that the adjustment in rates will have the following effects upon applicable Legacy EGSL customers' typical monthly bills (based on the Fuel Adjustment Clause and other riders for the month of November 2020): a typical monthly bill for a Residential customer using 1,000 kWh would increase approximately \$1.14, from \$96.91 to \$98.05; a typical monthly bill for a Small General Service customer using 5,000 kWh would increase approximately \$0.87, from \$570.38 to \$571.25; a typical monthly bill for a General Service customer using 500 kW and 255,500 kWh would increase approximately \$175.22, from \$16,946.04 to \$17,121.26.

The Police Jury of the Parish of Catahoula, State of Louisiana, met in Regular Session at its regular meeting place, the Police Jury Meeting Room at the Courthouse, on Monday, November 23, 2020 at 6:00 P.M.

Present: President Harold Sones, Vice President Jerel Evans and Jurors Brady Nelson, Glen McCormack, Rodney Sones, Rickie Crumpton and Debra Hawkins; Secretary Treasurer Patti C. Mizell, Assistant Secretary Frankie Tolar and Road Supervisor Charles Atkins.

Absent: Jurors Jeffery Estes and Johnnie Adams

A quorum being present, the Police Jury of the Parish of Catahoula, State of Louisiana, was duly convened as the governing authority of said parish by President Harold Sones, who called upon Rodney Sones for Prayer and requested that the Jurors and the public remain standing for the Pledge of Allegiance after which the following business was transacted.

On motion by Rickie Crumpton, seconded by Jerel Evans and unanimously passed, the Jury voted to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the last meeting and adopt same as published in the Official Journal.

On a motion by Glen McCormack seconded by Rodney Sones and unanimously passed, the Jury voted to approve the Agenda.

President Sones opened the Public Comment Period for the Agenda items. There were no comments.

There were no additions or deletions to Selective Maintenance.

Ms. Dorothy Oliver, Executive Director, LaSalle Community Action Association, stated that the Jury had approved a 5 year Public Housing Authority (PHA) plan last year, but HUD now requires an annual plan with any amendments be presented and approved. She also gave an update on the Section 8 Housing Program.

President Sones appointed Brady Nelson, Harold Sones and Rodney Sones to a scoring committee to meet on December 9, 2020 at 10:00 A.M. to score RFQ's for Grant Management.

On motion by Jerel Evans, seconded by Rodney Sones and unanimously passed, the Jury approved a lease agreement with the Village of Harrisonburg to lease property for a debris landfill site.

President Sones announced that a special meeting/public hearing will be held on Thursday, December 17, 2020 at 10:00 A.M. in the Police Jury Meeting Room, 301 Bushley Street, Room 104, Harrisonburg, LA to amend the 2020 budgets and approve the 2021 budgets.

President Sones announced that that Police Jury office and Maintenance Barn will be closed Thursday, November 26th and Friday November 27th, 2020 for the Thanksgiving Holiday.

On motion by Glen McCormack, seconded by Rodney Sones and unanimously passed, the Jury approved a quote from JEB Fencing to complete the fence on Duty Ferry Road.

Juror Rodney Sones announced that the Catahoula Parish Economic Development Board has set next week as Catahoula Parish Clean-up Week. He asked that everyone encourage businesses and residents to assist in helping to improve the parish with cleaning up.
